Owe nothing to anyone except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled *the law*. For this, “You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet,” and if there is any other commandment, it is **summed up in this saying**, “You shall **love** your neighbor as yourself.” Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of *the law*.
